

Dr. Guillaume Gruere, Senior Policy Analyst, Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD)

Guillaume Gruère is a Senior Policy Analyst in the OECD Trade and Agriculture Directorate, Natural Resource Policy Division. He leads OECD's work on agriculture and water, and oversees analyses on agriculture, water and climate change policies since 2013. He has recently published reports on the sustainable management of groundwater use in agriculture, surveying policies in 20 OECD countries, and on water risk hotspots for agriculture, which assessed future water risks for agriculture globally. Prior to joining OECD, he was a Senior Research Fellow at the International Food Policy Research Institute (IFPRI) in Washington DC, where he led research on agriculture and environmental policies in developing countries. He has authored or co-authored over 90 publications, including two journal articles that received research awards from the Agriculture and Applied Economics Association. G. Gruère holds a double M.S. in Agriculture Engineering and in Environment and Natural Resource Economics from AgroParisTech, France, and a Ph.D. in Agriculture and Resource Economics from the University of California, Davis, United States.
